Beneficiaries

Who benefits from the education and participation package?

Children and teenagers can claim education and participation support, if their parents receive one of the following benefits:

- Basic income support for job seekers in accordance with Book Two of the German Social Code – SGB II
- Social assistance according to Book Twelve of the German Social Code – SGB XII
- Social assistance according to the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act – AsylbLG
- Housing assistance (Wohngeld) or supplementary child allowance (Kinderzuschlag – §6, German Federal Child Benefit Act – BKGG)

in some cases also:

- Children and teenagers of low income families that do not receive any of the above mentioned benefits
- Young adults up to the age of 25 who still attend school and do not have any own income



Benefits

Which benefits will be financed?

- Lunch at school or day care
- Learning support/tutoring
- School excursions/
one or multiple day trips in day care
- School materials
– up to 100 € per year
- sports, cultural and leisure activities
– up to 120 € per year
- Student transportation
(restrictions apply)
